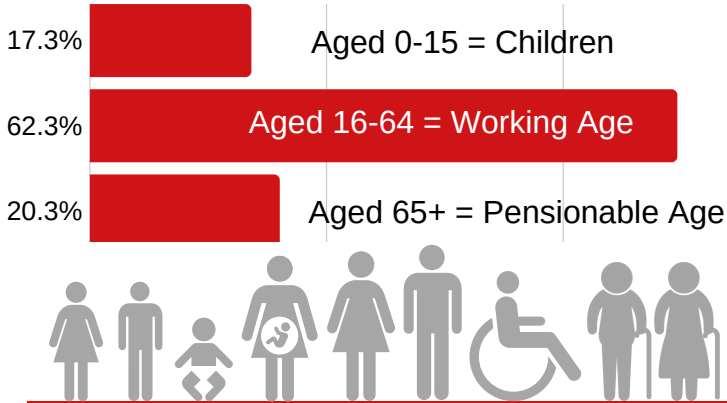

Age Demographics

Age refers to a person of a specific age (for example 40 year olds) or belonging to a specific age group (for example 0-15 or 16-64-year-olds).

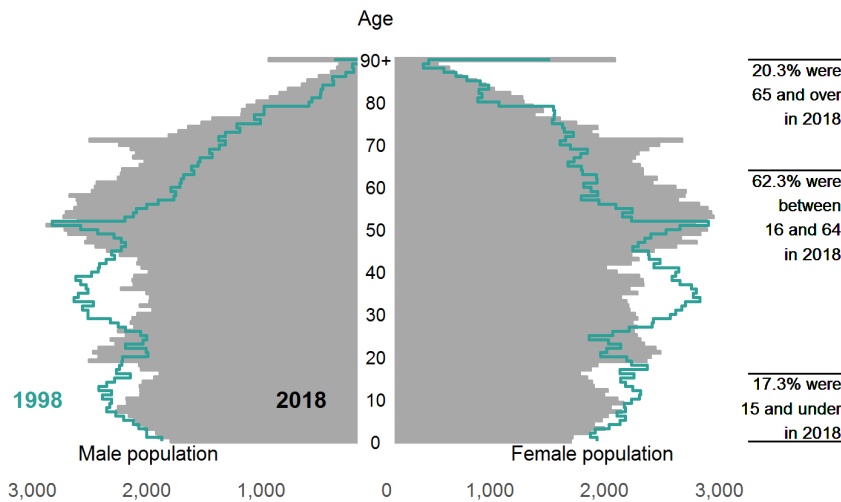

Population profile, 1998 and 2018



Between 1998 and 2018, the 25 to 44 age group saw the largest percentage decrease (-12.9%). The 65 to 74 age group saw the largest percentage increase (+39.3%).

There were 1,118 adults with a learning disability living in Fife in 2017-2018, with more males diagnosed across all age groups.

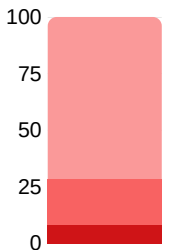
The 16-39 age group is the most likely to report discrimination and harassment.

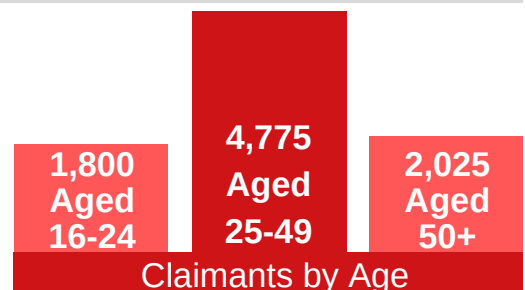
